Attached is a new IACUC Policy on Entering, Working & Visiting NUS animal facilities. You'll find information on the responsibilities & obligations of anyone entering, working or visiting NUS animal facilities. The policy will apply to academic research staff, post-docs, graduate / undergraduate students and non-NUS / NUHS persons including students and visitors on attachments. Please ensure your team & lab members are informed. You may wish to have the policy prominently placed in your lab notice boards / wall for reference.

Please be reminded that in compliance with NUS Safety Directive, <u>0701</u> *NUS Safety Directive Access to and Supervision of Undergraduates in Laboratories for Project or Research Work*, undergraduate students will not be given card access to the NUS vivariums and will need to be supervised in the animal facility by the PI or his/her nominee, provided the nominee is competent to carry out such supervision and agrees to do so.

IACUC & CM websites have information which would facilitate your research so do remember to visit them.
